Many complaints have been lodged about Spar. Serious intervention is needed from Department of Home Affairs, SAPS and Department of Labour.

Spar Supermarket has been on many organization’s radars since most employees have lodged complaints about the labour practices, especially the ill-treatment of employees.

We were not surprised when an employee from Spar Vorna Valley contacted us, complaining about victimization and unfair

dismissals. Other matters were raised and is currently confidential to pen in this newsletter.

We collaborated with COMBAT and attended to a hearing where the correct procedures were not followed.

It was stated that the employee has anger issues, while no licensed psychologist or any professional evaluated or diagnosed her!

No incident reports were submitted nor were there any colleagues or customers who experienced her “anger” or raised any safety concern.

After legal intervention the management faced challenges and the employee was vindicated.

Someone’s job was saved and we are a member richer!

A lesson learned

Even though we aim to serve at all cost, we are using resources, time and working with different people to assist South Africans wherever we can.

It was heartbreaking when we assisted a citizen after a labour dispute at Spar Danville and the person ignored our calls when he assumed that his matters have been settled.

It was more heartbreaking when he learned that his matters haven’t been resolved and he contacted us, needing our services again.

We did not even want remuneration, while we have paying members who haven’t asked for any of our service yet!

Let us please be considerate of one another and respect each other.
